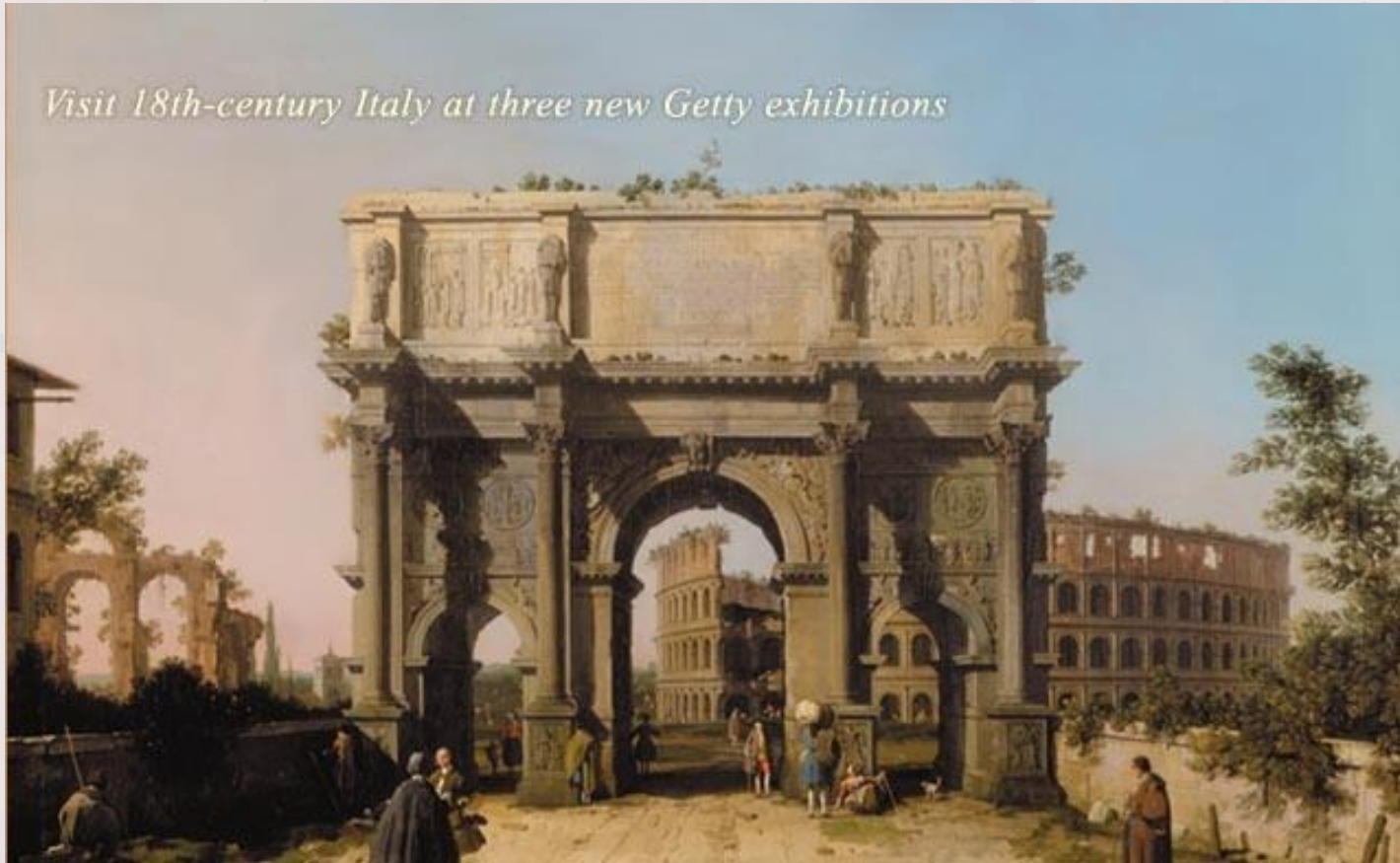

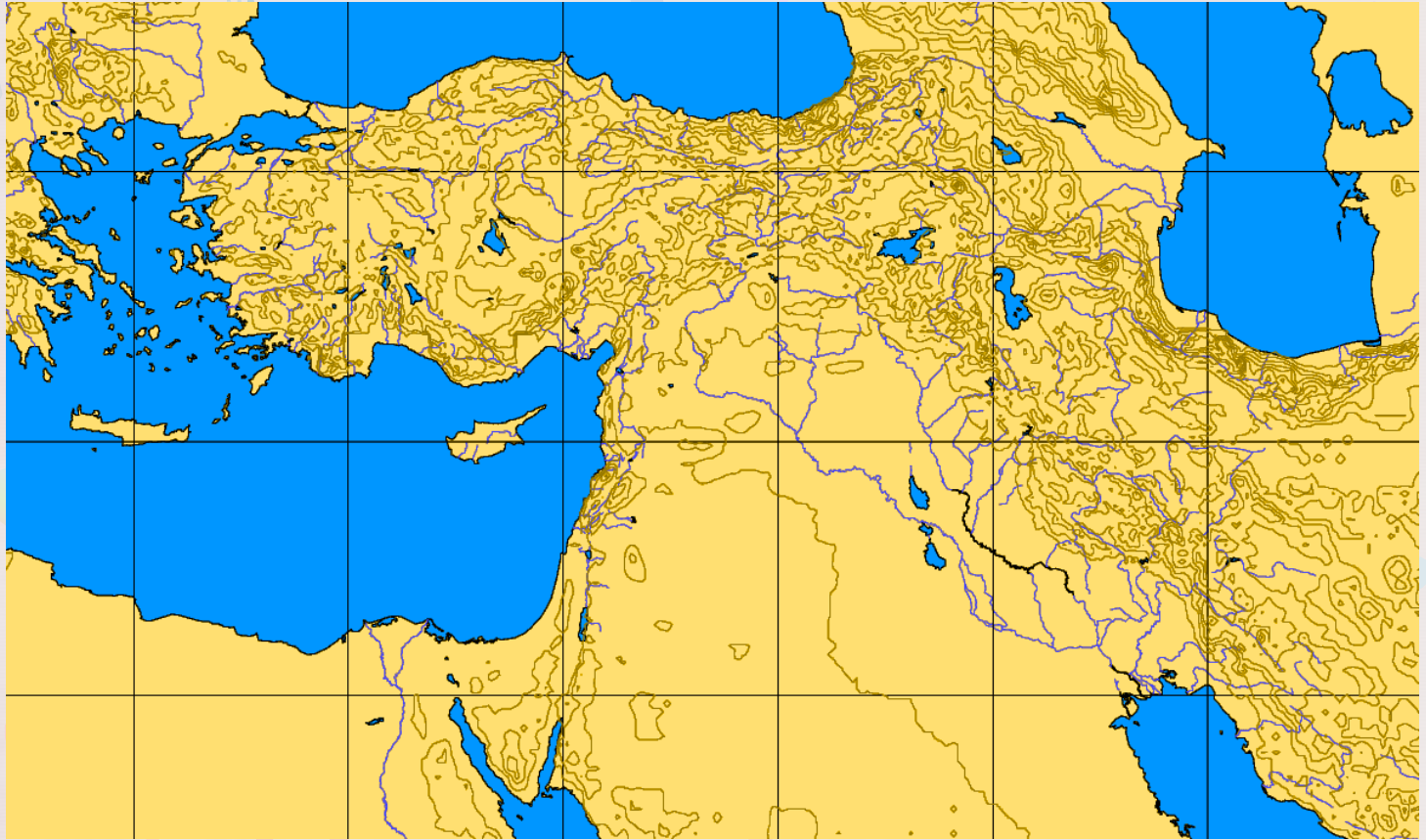

- attractive / repellent

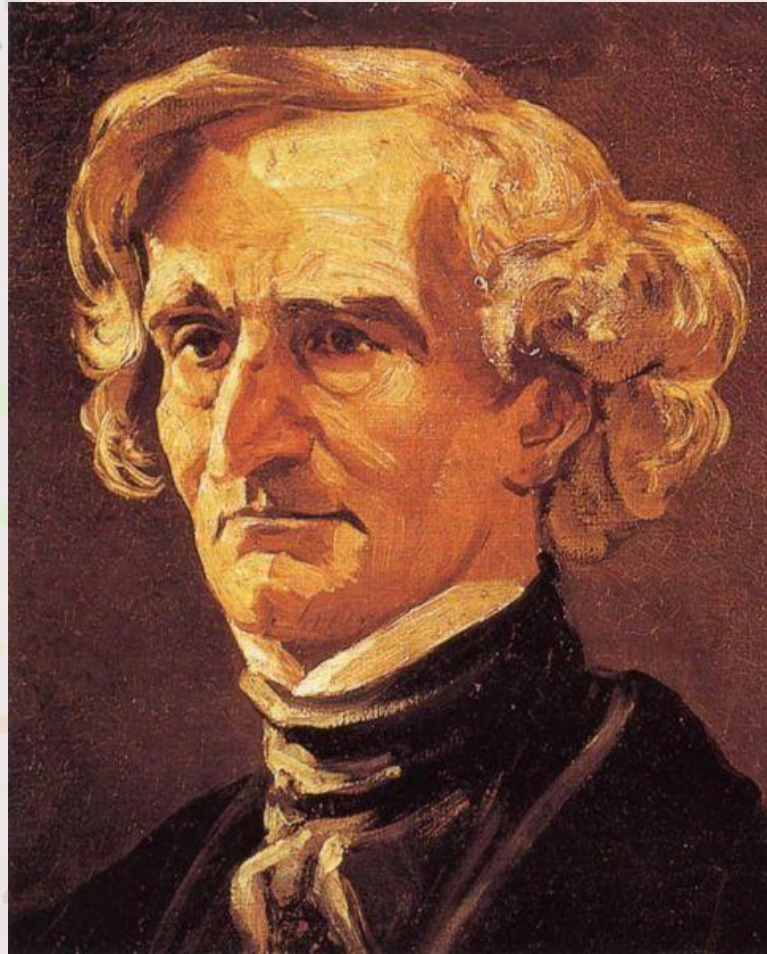
