Topic sentences

 A paragraph is a set of sentences that all relate to one main idea.

 The topic sentence is the sentence that tells that main idea.

 The first sentence of the paragraph is usually the topic sentence.

- The topic sentence must be specific and focused.
 - The topic sentence tells the reader what the paragraph is about.
 - The idea must be specific enough so that you can completely explain it in one paragraph.
 - The idea must be big enough so that you can say several interesting things about it.

Examples: These are not specific enough.

I will write about Harry Potter.

China is in Asia.

I like chocolate.

I learned something today.

Examples: These are too narrow.
China's population is 1,298,847,624 people.

Harry Potter and the Philosopher's Stone was published on June 26th, 1997.

Examples: These are good, clear, and specific.

Harry Potter and the Philosopher's Stone is a novel about a young wizard who attends a magic academy.

There are three main steps required to produce chocolate from cacao.

Forastero, criollo, and trinitario are the three types of cacao beans used to make chocolate.

How specific should I be?

- Your topic sentence should be specific enough so that you can completely explain the main idea in about 4 to 12 sentences.
- It should be general enough so that you can say at least two interesting things.

 (These are only approximate suggestions, but they are a good way to start practicing.)

Topic + Focus pattern

- First think about the general idea you will write about. This is your topic.
- Next, decide what specific things you want to say about the topic. This is your focus.
